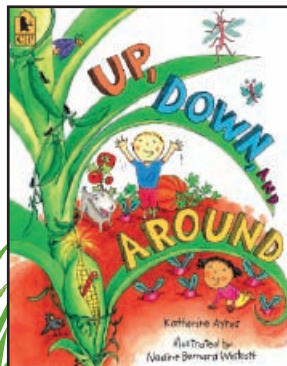




# KINDERGARTEN



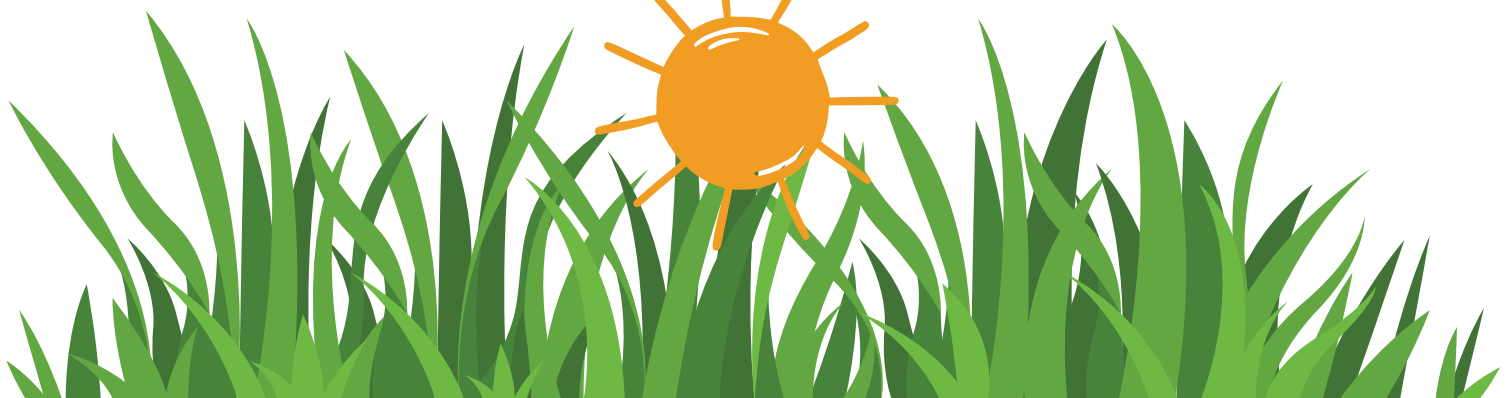

We accepted the Lettuce Challenge and competed with other schools in Stamford by growing lettuce in our classrooms.



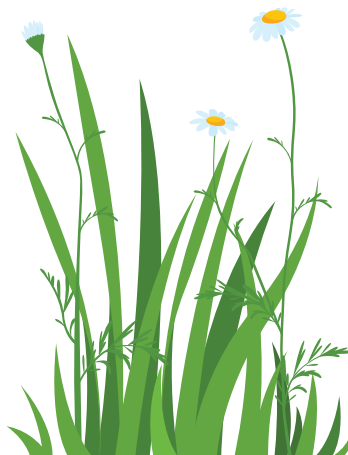




# 2ND GRADE

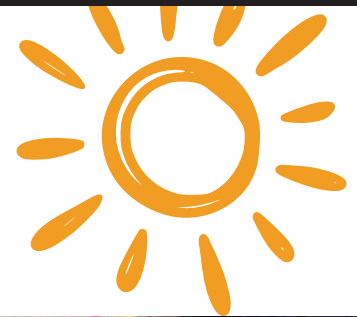






# 6TH GRADE

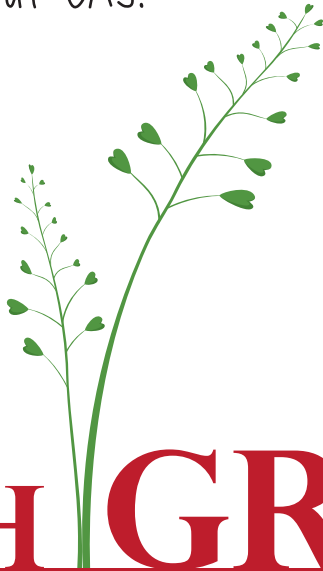
We grew an Italian herb garden with basil, parsley and oregano and helped to plan and celebrate Razzle Dazzle Day.
