- All records, referrals, and evaluations are maintained in accordance with federal and state confidentiality laws
- Information is released only with your written consent, except when required by law.
- Exceptions to Confidentiality:
 - Medical emergencies
 - Threat of harm to yourself or others
 - Suspected child or elder abuse or neglect.
 - Court order or subpoena

- Call **1-800-275-3327**
- Household members age 18 and older should contact EAP directly.
- Answer a few questions so we can match you with the right counselor.
- We'll notify the counselor that your sessions have been approved.
- Contact the counselor directly to schedule an appointment at your convenience.
- If the match isn't the right fit, simply call us back and we'll help you find another counselor.

What to Expect During Counseling?

- Your counselor will take time to understand your concerns, goals, and needs.
- Together, you'll discuss challenges, explore solutions, and develop practical strategies.
- Many people find it helpful to talk with a neutral, experienced professional in a confidential setting.
- If additional support is needed, your counselor may recommend ongoing counseling or other community resources.
- When possible, referrals are made to providers who participate with your health insurance. Ongoing services outside EAP may involve costs based on your insurance.
